Dear Mesdames and Messrs.:

Pursuant to C.G.S. Section 3-37(b), please find attached the monthly report for September 2012, which provides certain information regarding the State's cash position and bonding.

The report for September 2012 reflects an adequate overall cash balance. There were no transfers between the common cash pool and bond proceeds investment accounts during September or October 2012. Earlier today, however, we temporarily transferred monies from bond proceeds investment accounts to the common cash pool in accordance with the State's longstanding and sanctioned practice for managing fluctuations in the flow of cash to and from separate funds. More such transfers during November are likely.

While the common cash pool remains behind levels of a year ago, we continue to anticipate managing the State's cash flow requirements by use of the State's total available cash. Of course, further decline of the state's budget situation could present cash position issues, particularly in light of the FY13 General Fund GAAP deficit estimate of \$107.6 million by the Office of Policy and Management that was reported on October 19, 2012.

I will keep you updated as the fiscal year develops. In the meantime, should you have any questions, please feel free to call on me.
