Dear Mesdames and Messrs.:

Pursuant to C.G.S. Section 3-37(b), please find attached the monthly report for February 2014, which provides certain information regarding the State's cash position and bonding.

The report for February 2014 shows solid overall cash balances, which are consistent with the State's improving fiscal condition over the past 15 months.

Thus far this fiscal year, total available cash has averaged a robust \$2.0 billion, and the common cash pool -- which covers operating expenses -- has averaged approximately \$780 million. No transfers between bond proceeds investment accounts and the common cash pool have been necessary since April 2013.

As always, I will keep you updated on developments with our cash flow. In the meantime, should you have any questions, please feel free to call on me.
