Pursuant to Section 3-37(b) of the general statutes, please find attached the monthly report for March 2016, which provides certain information regarding the State's cash position and bonding.

The report for March 2016 shows adequate overall cash balances. No temporary transfers from bond proceeds investment accounts have been made since December 2014. As of April 30, 2016, our total available cash equaled \$1.9 billion. Although the recently released consensus revenue projections indicate a decline in expected state revenue, we anticipate adequate available cash balances for the remainder of the fiscal year.
