2009 - Sample Due Diligence Letter

- 1. Due diligence letters must be sent out to owners at their last-known address at least six months prior to presumption of abandonment is to take effect for the following property types: wages, salary, or other compensation and utility deposits or refunds.
- 2. **For all other property types**, due diligence letters must be sent out to owners at their last-known address within one year before presumption of abandonment is to take effect..
- 3. Put the Due Diligence Letter on company letterhead.
