## Monday: Treasurer Shawn Wooden Visits Covid-19 Vaccine Clinic In Waterbury And Applauds The City And Saint Mary's Hospital For Their Work To Help Close The Vaccine Equity Gap

Waterbury, CT - On Monday, April 19, 2021, Connecticut State Treasurer, Shawn T. Wooden will visit a COVID-19 vaccine clinic at Waterbury Arts Magnet School. This clinic was set up through a joint venture between Saint Mary's Hospital and the City of Waterbury and continues to bring COVID-19 vaccinations to socially vulnerable communities. The virus has had a disproportionate and devastating effect on communities of color that has led to higher infection rates, hospitalizations and mortalities. Last Monday, the State released new data that shows that Connecticut is still not hitting its equity allocation goals. As Connecticut's only Black statewide elected official, Treasurer Wooden has been using his voice to combat vaccine hesitancy among communities of color, while also urging the State to meet people where they are to help socially vulnerable communities get vaccinated. Treasurer Wooden will be joined by State Senator Joan Hartley, Waterbury Mayor Neil M. O'Leary and Dr. Husnain Kermalli, Chief Medical Officer of Saint Mary's Hospital.
