## **WEDNESDAY: TREASURER WOODEN JOINS LEGISLATIVE LEADERS TO URGE PASSAGE OF PROPOSED UNCLAIMED PROPERTY PROGRAM UPGRADES**

**Hartford, CT** - On Wednesday, March 30, 2022, at 12:30PM, **State Treasurer Shawn T. Wooden** will be joined by **Speaker Matt Ritter (D-Hartford), Majority Leader Jason Rojas (D-East Hartford, Manchester), and other legislative leaders** to urge passage of **Senate Bill 379**, An Act Implementing the Treasurer's Recommendations Concerning the Unclaimed Property Program. Senate Bill 379 is the most comprehensive unclaimed property bill under consideration by the Legislature this session. The bill will build upon administrative improvements made by the Treasurer and further enhance Connecticut's unclaimed property program. Among other enhancements, the bill would enable the automatic payment of unclaimed property valued under \$2,500 for sole property owners.
