Active Killer Incident Response Training

Objective: Prepare patrol officers to respond effectively to active killer incidents, emphasizing swift response, individual and team movement, and post-engagement considerations. Special emphasis will be placed on single-person response strategies to enhance officers' ability to act decisively in high-stress situations.

Overview: Recent events highlight the need for law enforcement officers to respond promptly and decisively to active killer incidents. This training will cover dispatch and arrival procedures, individual and team movement tactics, and integrated response scenarios involving Police, Fire, and EMS assets. Participants will receive specialized instruction on tactics and data-driven techniques, empowering them to take immediate action when necessary.

Instructors: Led by members of the Connecticut State Police Tactical Team in conjunction with Connecticut State Police Training Academy Staff.

Credits: POST credit will be awarded upon completion of the training.
