SECTION _____

Section 1

Paragraph 4 of the General Instructions of the Uniform System of Accounts prescribed for Gas Utilities, pursuant to Section 16-27-3 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, is amended to read as follows:

4. Accounting Period

Each utility shall keep its books on a monthly basis so that for each month all transactions applicable thereto, as nearly as may be ascertained, shall be entered in the books of the utility. Amounts applicable or assignable to specific utility departments shall be so segregated monthly. Each utility shall close its books at the end of each calendar year, EXCEPT THAT A UTILITY MAY CLOSE ITS BOOKS AT THE END OF A DIFFERENT ACCOUNTING PERIOD, UPON PRIOR APPROVAL, AND FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN.

Statement of Purpose: To allow a gas utility, as defined in the Uniform System of Accounts prescribed for Gas Utilities, to adopt a fiscal year ending as of a date other than the end of the calendar year, upon a showing of good cause, and subject to the prior approval of the Department.
