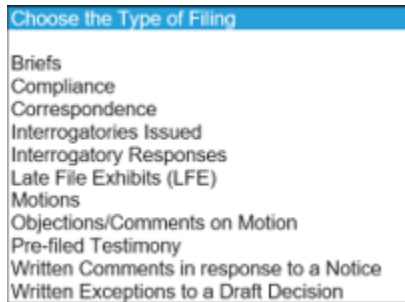


Definitions



Briefs: Briefs and reply briefs are filed by Parties and intervenors after the close of discovery

Compliance: Orders cited in the approved Decision

Interrogatories Issued: Usually issued by PURA staff

Interrogatory Responses: Use only if you were issued specific Interrogatories and are responding

Late File Exhibits: Supplemental data of the witness

Motions: Generally, fall into the following categories

- requests for party, intervenor, or participant status
- requests for extension of time
- requests for protective orders
- requests for hearing
- requests to withdraw the filing
- requests to reopen a docket

Objections/Comments on Motion: Categories for Objections/Comments

- Comment
- Objection
- Supplemental Filing
- Withdraw
- Other

Pre-filed Testimony: A written document and is considered evidence. It provides the position of the party/participant concerning issues in a docket; often provided by an “expert witness” in contested cases.

Written Comments in Response to a Notice: Members of the public may submit written comments

Written Exceptions to a Draft Decision: A written document (unlike oral arguments which are verbal) that explains why a participant/party disagrees with or requests changes to one of PURA’s Draft Decisions.
