Prior to the meeting, Eversource and UI circulated a revised version of the guidelines, which were the focus of discussion during the meeting

- Carl discussed revisions to the guidelines that differentiated between applicants and customers. The intent is to have two sets of communications, one more technical to be directed towards applicants (solar developers) and another to customers (homeowners).
- Mike Farrell agreed that splitting communications makes sense but wants to ensure that both customers and applicants receive communications
- Carl stated that Section 1.11 was added to ensure that installers are aware of applicable standards and rules
- Members discussed new Section 1.13, which sets out certain responsibilities for applicants regarding the information they must provide customers. The draft language included the responsibility to inform customers of "realistic timeframes for interconnection." Several members 0
