3. <u>Civic Mind contest of Capital Regional Development Authority Request for Proposals #18-001</u>

- Hartford Sports Group (HSG) did not submit a timely response to the RFP
- o Contract does not comport with the RFP

- 3. Does the CRDA have written procurement procedures? If so, would you please provide us with a copy?
- 4. Who at CRDA was assigned to receive and note the receipt of proposals in the above-captioned matter?
- 5. Did CRDA evaluate the proposals? If so, who was on the evaluation team?
- 6. If evaluated, would you provide us with a copy of those evaluations?
- 7. Did the nature of the RFP change after the submittal of the proposals, i.e., upgrades and repairs to Dillon Stadium and the operational management program?
- 8. Please provide to us copies of the proposals received with respect to #18-001
- 9. After the receipt of the proposals, were there any announcement made by email to the proposers? If so, please provide to us a copy of those emails.
- 10. To date, have any of the HSG funds received by CRDA been expended?

Motion included setting the next meeting date and time for 1:00 P.M. November 20, 2018 and inviting Michael Freimuth, Executive Director of the Capital Region Development Authority, and contester Thomas J. Clynch of Civic Mind, LLC to the meeting and to inform Mayor Luke Bronin of the City of Hartford of the contest and the next meeting date and time.
