The current version of the GED® Test **will expire** on December 31, 2013 and your scores will expire too. If you have started the GED® but you haven't finished, you have until the end of this year to complete and pass all parts of the GED® Test. **If you don't, all of your scores will expire and you will have to start over.**

Why will your test scores expire?

Starting on January 2, 2014, there will be a new GED® Test. The new GED® will be offered only on computer. There are also a number of other changes you can find out about by clicking this link:
