## Systemic Response to School Absence's


- Revamped the BOE attendance policy to fit the state attendance laws.

## Case Management

- Individual monitoring








Chronic Absences: 18 or more total absences (10% of school missed)

Truant: 10 or more Unexcused Absences or 4 absences in a month


#### **Total Unexcused Absences at VCMS**






