**SUBJECT:** Request for Finance Advisory Committee Action

When an agency needs to transfer funds between state accounts over a certain dollar threshold, it must make a request to the Office of Policy and Management that the transfer be considered by the Finance Advisory Committee (FAC).

The Department has requested a transfer of \$1,000,000 from the CT Technical Education System Personal Services account to the Technical High School-Other Expenses account.

**Transfer of funds from the CT Technical Education System Account      \$1,000,000**

Funds are available in the Personal Services account due to attrition and the timing of refills of vacant positions.

**Transfer of funds to the CT Technical High School – Other Expenses  
Account      \$1,000,000**

These funds will be used to fund the cost of utilities and minor repairs through the close of the school year. The transfer is necessary due to an increase in infrastructure repair costs at Platt, Bullard Havens, and Windham Technical High Schools, which are all awaiting school renovation projects, costs associated with the expansion of the Information Systems Technology trade programs, and other contractual costs.
