She highlighted the work and efforts of East Hartford Public Schools with minority teacher recruitment. Ms. Parisi welcomed Mr. Nathan Quesnel, Superintendent of East Hartford Public Schools, and Christopher Wethje, Director of Human Resources of East Hartford Public Schools, to highlight the current work of the district.

East Hartford Public Schools shared highlights and ongoing efforts to strengthen minority teacher recruitment and culture competency.
