### III. New Haven Public Schools Alliance District Progress Update

The three areas of concern are literacy, mathematics, and chronic absenteeism. Strategies were provided for each goal to support and continue to maintain their improved outcomes.

Superintendent Ilene Tracy provided an update on Goal 1 – Literacy. She shared progress to date on the implementation of progress monitoring, small group instruction, and professional development for literacy. Committee Chair Benham opened the floor to Committee members for questions and comments.

Supervisor of Math Monica Joyner provided an update on Goal 2 – Mathematics. She shared progress to date on the implementation of progress monitoring, small group instruction, and professional development for mathematics. Committee Chair Benham opened the floor to Committee members for questions and comments.

Gemma Joseph-Lumpkin, Chief of Youth, Family, and Community Engagement, and Typhanie Jackson, Director of Student Services provided an update on Goal 3 – Chronic Absenteeism. They shared progress to date on the implementation of family engagement, attendance teams, and community partners.
