



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## How to Motivate Parents

- Start the process before 12th grade
  - Middle School "Financial Planning Seminars"-
- Communicate consistently and with a variety of touchpoints
  Email, text, social media
- Understand your community.
  - Translate printed information into the language(s) spoken by local parents. Schedule events during the evening and on the weekends. Provide transportation or vouchers. Offer child care and food.

#### Rename your events:

- "Financial Aid Workshop" to "CA\$H Labs"
- "Scholarship Night" to "Pizza for Dollar\$"
- Workshops that focus on "Credit and Debt Management for Parents- early on
