### **Enjoy the Book Together**

- Zapatos is the Spanish word for shoes, and Freddie Ramos has some very special zapatos! They make him run super fast and jump super high, just like a superhero! Freddie uses his shoes to save people in need. As you read, talk about what superpowers you and your child would like to have if you were superheroes. Why would you choose that power? How could you save people with this power?
- The author uses bold words for phrases like "Zoom! Zoom! Zapato!" and "Flip! Flop! Flip! Flop." As you read, notice these words. Discuss why you think the author chose to make these words bold.

#### **Make Personal Connections**

- When Freddie is scared that Erika is going to make him pay for taking back the wallet, he goes for a run. Freddie runs so fast in his super *zapatos* and feels much better after the run. Talk with your child about what you both do to feel better when you're nervous.
- Freddie loses his backpack with his special *zapatos* inside! Pretend you two have lost something important. Where will you look?
