

PLAY AND LEISURE SUPPORTS

Play, recreation, and leisure are critical for all students - especially now during the COVID-19 "Stay Home, Stay Safe" period. They provide a much needed mental break/shift from lessons, and they can also provide much needed gross motor and sensory input. These kinds of activities may be more challenging for students with high needs. They may not have the social skills to play board games or outdoor games with others. They may have unsafe behaviors that interfere with their ability to use manipulatives or lack the fine motor skills to use them effectively. Yet, with some creativity and persistence, students with high needs can have fun and reap the benefits of play as well.
