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### **Executive Orders**

#### • Executive Order 7C:

 Addressed evolving circumstances suggesting a longer term school class cancelation by clarifying the waiver of the requirement for 180 day school year, allowing all districts to close on their normally scheduled enddate, so long as they provide continued educational opportunities to the greatest extent possible

#### • Executive Order 7 M:

 Authorized commissioners of state agencies to suspend or modify administrative deadlines

#### • Executive Order 7 R:

 Addressed funding for boards of education, sustaining staff, and contracts including with Special Education Providers
