Connecticut Core Standards Higher Education Summer Institute

Designed specifically for members of the higher education community, this two-day institute will offer participants a variety of breakout sessions with the newest information about the Connecticut Core Standards for ELA/Literacy and Mathematics and teacher preparation programs.
