#### Potential Reader/Task Challenges

The title is deceiving in that the title is not the main idea, but a piece of the big idea. Students may get stuck on how fathers are the sole providers of their eggs and chicks because the title is "A Caring Father". That thought might block out the details on how a mother is important as well.

### Big Takeaway

The title is not always the central idea of a text. Students should be able to identify the key details of the story to gather meaning about the main idea. Students should be able to identify key details about the mother and father penguin and the different things they do to take care of their eggs/ chicks. The students should be able to refer to the key details to help provide evidence to specific questions.
