The Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) strongly encourages your school's participation in the Career and Technical Education Career Clusters (CTE) BINGO Challenge. This challenge will support and enhance your ongoing efforts to keep career awareness and exploration skills an integral part of student learning by having students investigate today's skills for tomorrow's careers.
