SUBJECT:	2021–22 Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (Perkins V) Intent to Apply Process

The 2021–22 Perkins V Intent to Apply process is open until June 11, 2021. This process assists the Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) in the compilation of a list of eligible Connecticut secondary recipients intending to apply for the Perkins V funding for the 2021–22 school year and in grant calculation purposes.

Eligible Connecticut secondary recipients who signal their intent to apply are required to:

- Increase the involvement of business and industry stakeholders;
- Adhere to Connecticut's definitions of <u>Size, Scope, and Quality</u>; and
- Complete the federally mandated <u>Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment (CLNA)</u> process (if not completed for the 2020–21 year).
