Dear Superintendent,

The Connecticut State Department of Education, with the assistance of the Division of Emergency Management and Homeland Security (DEMHS) and the Connecticut National Guard, will be distributing the second round of masks to school districts. These **youth masks** have been allocated using the same methodology that the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) applied to the national allocation, which was based on Free and Reduced Price Lunches. Masks will be distributed as outlined below beginning on Monday, October 19, 2020, between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. As with the adult mask distribution, DEMHS will notify local emergency management directors to assist with your district’s pickup and distribution.

For planning purposes, the attached spreadsheet contains the number of masks and boxes you will be receiving, as well as the DEMHS Region in which each district is assigned. Box dimensions are 17” by 16” by 11”, so please be sure the vehicles have sufficient storage to accommodate pickup. Due to the size of the shipment, highlighted districts with a blank allocation amount will receive a separate communication to coordinate direct delivery by DEMHS.
