The Center will help more Connecticut students develop strong reading skills by providing resources and support to districts, schools, and families.

- Districts have access to ReadConn Virtual to support teachers in planning intensive reading instruction based on required foundational skills aligned with the science of reading.
- Districts will have access to science of reading research and an implementation toolkit by Spring 2022.
- Districts will have an approved list of evaluated Model Curricula or Reading Programs by July 1, 2022.
