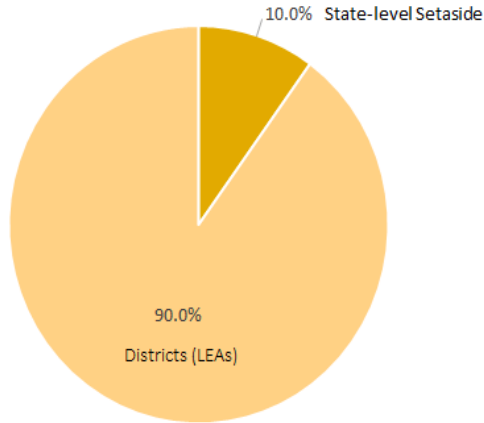


Connecticut Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Fund Investments

\$1.7 billion in total Federal ESSER funds have been given to Connecticut since the start of the pandemic, in three installments (ESSER I, ESSER II, and ARP ESSER)
90% (~\$1.54 billion) is reserved for use at the district level.
10% (~\$171 million) is reserved for use at the state level, including one-time investments that are self-sustaining and have measurable impact.

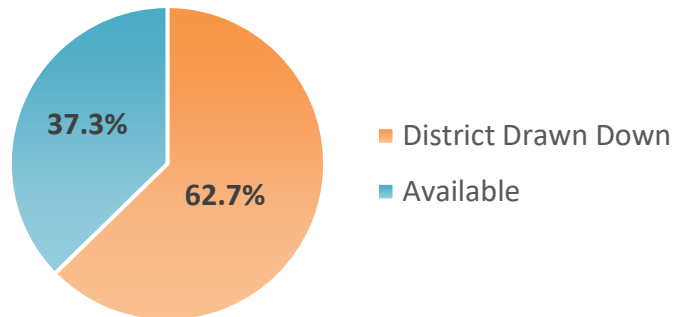
Total Awarded: **\$111 million**
 Districts (LEAs): \$99.9 million
 State-level set-aside: \$11.1 million
 Funds available through 9/30/2022

**All funds have been drawn down as of 9/30/2022.
 Liquidation period is underway.**

ESSER II

Total Awarded: **\$492.4 million**
 Districts (LEAs): \$443.2 million
 State-level set-aside: \$49.2 million
 Funds available through 9/30/2023

ARP ESSER

Total Awarded: **\$1.1 billion**

Districts (LEAs): \$995 million

Required reservation:

- \$199 million to address learning loss

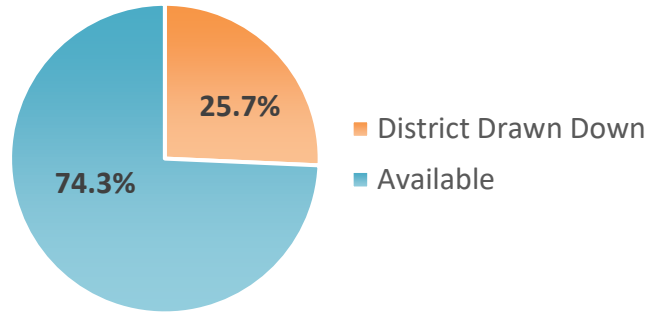
State-level set-aside: \$110 million

Required reservation:

- \$55 million to address learning loss
- \$11 million for summer enrichment
- \$11 million for afterschool programs

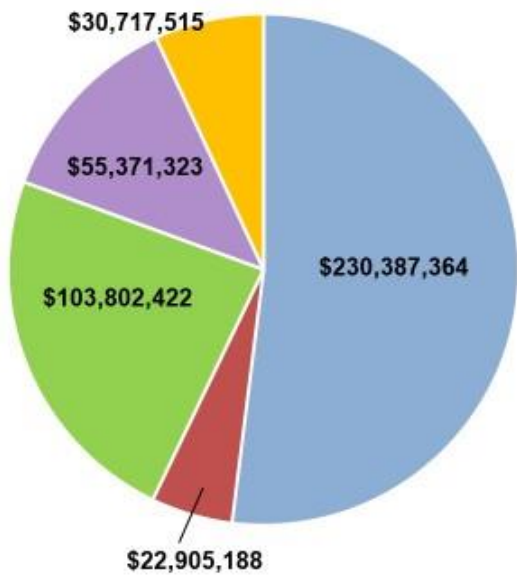

ARP ESSER - Funds Drawn Down by Districts

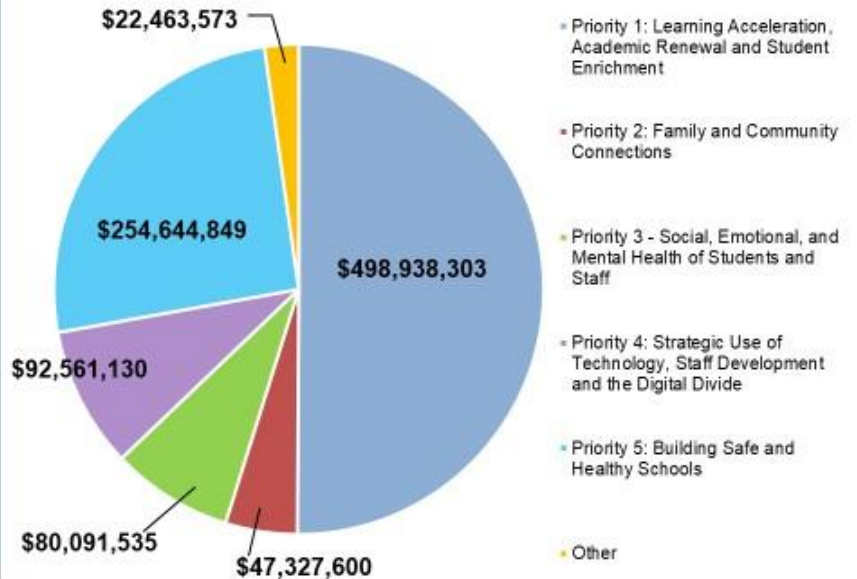


District Investments by Priority Area

District Investments by Priority Area



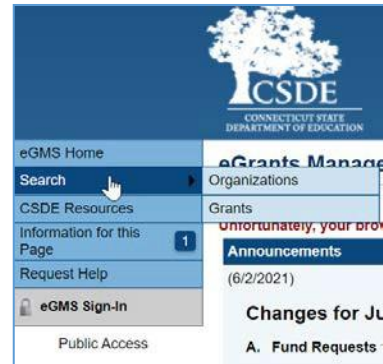
ARP ESSER

Note: Only approved applications are viewable to the public. Application versions that are still in process will not be accessible.

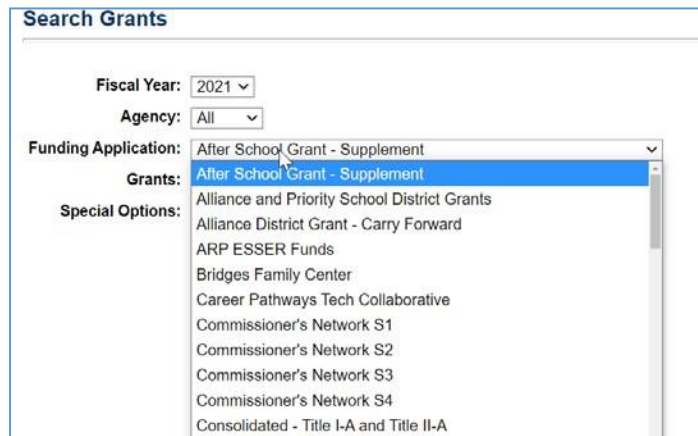
1. Go to the eGMS Home Page
<https://connecticut.egrantsmanagement.com>. (This page also includes links to training videos and guides that will assist you in navigating the eGMS site.)



2. On the upper left menu, hover over “Search” and select “Grants.”

3. Select Fiscal Year 2021

4. In the “Funding Application” dropdown, select ARP ESSER or ESSER II. (Note: ESSER I is Fiscal Year 2020 and named “ESSER Funds.”)



5. Hit “Search” and all approved applications will populate in alphabetical order by district.

6. Select the district you wish to view. You can view by object, which separates into different spending categories. Or, you can select “Budget by Purpose” which will present all expenditures in one category.
