(Perkins V) Intent to Apply Process

The 2025-26 Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (Perkins V) Intent to Apply process is open now through **Friday**, **June 13**, **2025**. This process assists the Connecticut State Department of Education in the compilation of a list of eligible Connecticut recipients intending to apply for the Perkins V Funding.

Eligible Connecticut recipients who indicate their intent to apply are required to:

- increase the involvement of business and industry stakeholders;
- adhere to Connecticut's definitions of Size, Scope, and Quality; and
- complete the federally mandated Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment (CLNA).

Complete the 2025-26 Perkins V Intent to Apply Survey by Friday, June 13, 2025, at 5:00 p.m.
