 - A. First, **SEC. 1.101 Definitions** is proposed to be amended to add a definition for "Equivalent Stature." The Rules Committee recommended this addition to clarify and ensure consistency in the application of this term in the proposed amendment to Rule SEC. 4.103 Transfers During Senior Year.
 - B. Second, **SEC. 4.103 Transfers During Senior Year, subsection (b) Equivalent Stature and Course Waivers**, is proposed to be amended to incorporate and rely upon the newly defined term as it relates to type of diploma a transferring senior is to receive. The inclusion of the "Equivalent Stature" definition in SEC. 1.101 is intended to support uniform interpretation and implementation of the standards referenced in SEC. 4.103(b), and to reduce ambiguity when evaluating waiver requests.

DoWea Grant Military-Connected Schools Construction, Modernization and Facilities Maintenance Program Grant [Search Results Detail | Grants.gov](#): To be eligible, an LEA must be eligible to receive U.S. Department of Education Impact Aid Basic Support Payments under Section 7003(b), and target schools must have 15 percent or more military-connected student enrollment at the time of application. For the purposes of this program, military-connected students are defined as the children of members of the uniformed services and children whose parents work on Federal property.
