

PROPOSED RULE AMENDMENT

SEC. 4.103 | Transfers During Senior Year

(a) Transfers During Senior Year – There may be cases in which a military student transferring at the beginning or during his or her senior year is ineligible to graduate from the receiving LEA after all alternatives have been considered. In such cases the sending and receiving LEA's shall ensure the receipt of a diploma from the sending LEA, if the student meets the graduation requirements of the sending LEA. In the event that one of the states in question is not a member of this compact, the member state shall use best efforts to facilitate the on-time graduation of the student in accordance with Article VII, Sections A and B of ~~this Article~~ the Compact.

(b) Equivalent Stature and Course Waivers – Consistent with Article I, Section B. of the Compact, every effort shall be made by the receiving LEA to ensure that the type of diploma a transferring senior is to receive is of the equivalent stature to that which the student had worked towards in the sending LEA, without placing an unreasonable burden on the student (e.g., requiring additional classes above those required by the sending LEA). If the receiving LEA cannot waive additional courses without damaging the academic integrity of the diploma type being sought, the receiving LEA shall work collaboratively with the sending LEA to facilitate the receipt of a diploma of equivalent statutes from the sending LEA.
