

Temporary Adjustments Authorized Under the Keep Kids Fed Act of 2022

The reimbursement rates in this operational memorandum reflect the June 30, 2023, expiration of the temporary reimbursement rates provided under the Keep Kids Fed Act of 2022 (Public Law 117– 158), which included an additional 10 cents per meal reimbursement rate and temporary Tier I reimbursement rates for Tier II family day care homes. The reimbursement rates in this operational memorandum reflect an adjustment to the base rates from 2022-2023.
