This document provides information on Connecticut's site eligible schools for the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program (FFVP), of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), effective February 1, 2023. Site eligible schools are schools where at least 50 percent of children are eligible for free and reduced-price meals. These schools cannot be used to determine if other sites under the CACFP, SFSP, SSO, FFVP, and ASP are eligible.

Free and reduced-price percentages are calculated annually by the Connecticut State Department of Education's (CSDE) Child Nutrition Programs based on October data from the previous school year. In districts implementing the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP), the free and reduced-price percentage might not be reflective of individual children's eligibility status.
