

List of Site Eligible Schools for the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program (October 2022 Data)

This document provides information on Connecticut's site eligible schools for the [Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program \(FFVP\)](#), of the [National School Lunch Program \(NSLP\)](#), effective February 1, 2023. Site eligible schools are schools where at least 50 percent of children are eligible for free and reduced-price meals. These schools cannot be used to determine if other sites under the CACFP, SFSP, SSO, FFVP, and ASP are eligible.

Free and reduced-price percentages are calculated annually by the Connecticut State Department of Education's (CSDE) Child Nutrition Programs based on October data from the previous school year. In districts implementing the [Community Eligibility Provision \(CEP\)](#), the free and reduced-price percentage might not be reflective of individual children's eligibility status.
