

# List of Site Eligible Schools for the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program (October 2025 Data)

This document provides information on Connecticut’s site eligible schools for the U.S. Department of Agriculture’s (USDA) [Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program](#) (FFVP) of the [National School Lunch Program](#) (NSLP), effective February 1, 2026. Site eligible schools are schools where at least 50 percent of children are eligible for free and reduced-price meals. These schools cannot be used to determine if other sites under the FFVP are eligible. Schools must be elementary schools; defined as schools inclusive of any grade between kindergarten and grade 6 (e.g., Pre-K-6, K-12, and 5-8). All students in selected schools must participate in the FFVP

Free and reduced-price percentages are calculated annually by the Connecticut State Department of Education’s (CSDE) Child Nutrition Programs based on October data from the previous school year. In districts implementing the [Community Eligibility Provision](#) (CEP), the free and reduced-price percentage might not be reflective of individual children’s eligibility status
