The Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) is in the process of reissuing and revising the FNS Instructions pertaining to the Child Nutrition Programs. The instructions are being reissued to ensure current program policy and authority are accurately reflected and to adhere to new formatting requirements for FNS Instructions, including adding a purpose statement in some cases. All divisions are undergoing the same revision process to update FNS Instructions.

Modifications to FNS Instructions related to Child Nutrition Programs are divided into four categories; minor edits, revised, pending reissuance and obsolete. Format and citation updates will be made to documents listed under the minor edits category while major revisions such as additional program or policy changes are listed as revised. Instructions pending reissuance will be revised in the future. Instructions that no longer reflect FNS policy or that have been incorporated in the regulations have been deemed obsolete. These instructions should be removed from any State website or policy references. A list of the current FNS Instructions set for revision is attached to this memo.

All FNS Instructions are considered current until their reissuance is complete or their status is changed to obsolete. For this reason, it is important that you wait to remove instructions until notice of further action is received. Please review your websites for previous versions of the FNS Instructions and replace them with the revised versions as you receive notification of reissuance status on the FNS PartnerWeb.

The reissuance of FNS Instructions began in early November 2010 and will continue until all of the instructions have been reissued or revised. Please continue to monitor the FNS PartnerWeb and FNS wide emails for further updates. When Instructions are posted to the CND Policy and Memo Community of the FNS PartnerWeb, all Community members will receive an email notification. FNS Instructions reside in the Resources and Guidance documents library, in the FNS Instructions folder.
