Revised Questions and Answers Related to the Certification of Compliance with Meal Requirements for the National School Lunch Program

Attached is the U.S. Department of Agriculture’s (USDA) revised questions and answers related to the interim rule entitled, *Certification of Compliance with Meal Requirements for the National School Lunch Program under the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010*. Under section 201 of the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010, an additional reimbursement of 6 cents per lunch is available for school food authorities certified to be in compliance with the new school meal patterns. The interim rule establishes the requirements related to certification and this new performance-based reimbursement.

The attached handout, “USDA Questions and Answers on Certification of Compliance with Meal Requirements,” updates the USDA guidance previously released on April 27, 2012, and June 11, 2012. It addresses questions received by the USDA and provides additional information on these requirements. New questions are in *red italics*.
