Federal Small Purchase Threshold Adjustment

There has been a change in the Federal Small Purchase Threshold as it relates to all Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) program procurements under Federal grants. The simplified acquisition threshold is confirmed as \$150,000; replacing the previous threshold of \$100,000. The change was made through statutorily required administrative action.

State and local agencies may use the simplified acquisition procedures for small purchases up to the threshold set by 41 U.S.C. 403(11), which is \$150,000. This increase in the threshold will allow for more small purchase procurements to be conducted using relatively simple and informal methods for securing services, supplies, or other property [7 CFR §3016.36(d)] provided that each procurement, regardless of amount, is conducted in a manner that *ensures free and open competition*. It is important to note that local agencies may set a lower small purchase threshold and thereby impose more restrictive procurement procedures as authorized by 7 CFR §3016.36(a), §3016.37(a), and §3016.60(a). Therefore, all local procurement requirements still apply and school food authorities must check with their business official to determine if their local requirements are more restrictive than the federal regulations.
