Payment of Fiscal Year 2020-21 State Funds for the National School Lunch

Program

U.S. Department of Agriculture regulations (7 CFR 210.17) require states to appropriate a minimum level of state funds ("state match") to be paid as reimbursement to school food authorities (SFAs) that participate in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP). The funding level for Connecticut's state match is \$2,354,000.

The Connecticut State Department of Education's (CSDE) calculation for state match payments historically included lunch meal counts from the following Child Nutrition Programs (CNP):

- NSLP (program year July 1 through June 30 of the following year); and
- Seamless Summer Option (SSO) of the NSLP (after the end of the academic school year through the start of the next academic school year).

Due to the public health emergency created by COVID-19, the USDA authorized numerous flexibilities which allowed SFAs to provide lunch meals using alternate USDA nutrition programs. On April 19, 2021, the USDA provided guidance to state agencies (SP 10-2021, *Questions and Answers Regarding Child Nutrition Program Oversight, Administration, and Reporting During COVID-19*) on meeting the state match requirements as outlined in 7 CFR 210.17 for SY 2020-21 in light of the nationwide waiver flexibilities implemented in SY 2019-20.

As a result of this guidance, the CSDE has established a state match calculation to equitably distribute state match funds for SY 2020-21 based on the SFA meeting each of the four criteria below:

- 1. The SFA is currently serving lunch under the NSLP, Summer Food Service Program (SFSP), or the SSO.
- 2. If not currently operating, the SFA has notified the CSDE of the intent to operate at the end of the public health emergency.
- 3. The SFA participated in the NSLP during SY 2019-20.
- 4. The SFA has NSLP lunch counts from July 1, 2019, through March 30, 2020.

The CSDE has issued state match payments for FY 2020-21 to SFAs that have met the established state match criteria. Typically state match payments are provided in two installments, however, for fiscal year (FY) 2020-21, the full state match payment has been provided in one payment.
