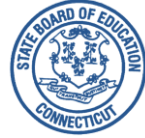

SUBJECT: Operational Memorandum No. 09-22
State Severe Need School Breakfast Program Grant for School Year 2021-22

In accordance with legislative changes regarding available grants and funding pursuant to state statutes for school nutrition programs for school year (SY) 2021-22, attached is a list of school food authorities (SFA) with sites that qualify for the State Severe Need School Breakfast Program (SBP) basic grant for SY 2021-22.

For the purpose of the grant, qualifying schools have met all three criteria below.

1. Participated in the SBP or offered breakfast meals through the Seamless Summer Option (SSO) of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) or Summer Food Service Program during SY 2020-21 and/or had indicated their intent to the Connecticut State Department of Education to participate in the SBP during SY 2021-22.
2. Are currently a school site serving breakfast under the SBP or SSO.
3. Meet the statutory definition of Severe Need (i.e., 20-percent of the lunches served under the NSLP in the 2nd prior year were served to students eligible for free or reduced-price meals) for SY 2019-20.

Based on the availability of funds SFAs will receive approximately \$2,649 per eligible site(s).
