SUBJECT: Operational Memorandum No. 10-23

Payment of Fiscal Year 2022-23 State Funds for the National School Lunch Program

U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) regulations (7 CFR 210.17) require states to appropriate a minimum level of state funds ("state match") to be paid as reimbursement to school food authorities (SFAs) that participate in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP). The funding level for Connecticut's state match is \$2,354,000.

The Connecticut State Department of Education's (CSDE) calculation for state match payments historically included lunch meal counts from the following Child Nutrition Programs (CNP):

- NSLP (program year July 1 through June 30 of the following year); and
- Seamless Summer Option (SSO) of the NSLP (after the end of the academic school year through the start of the next academic school year).

For school year (SY) 2022-23, the CSDE has established a state match calculation to equitably distribute state match funds based on the SFA meeting each of the three criteria below.

- 1. The SFA is currently serving lunch under the NSLP.
- 2. The SFA participated in the NSLP or SSO during SY 2021-22 under their own CNP sponsor agreement.
- 3. The SFA has NSLP counts from July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022; or the SFA has SSO lunch counts from July 1, 2021, through September 30, 2022 (including community sites).

The CSDE has issued state match payments for fiscal year (FY) 2022-23 to SFAs meeting the established state match criteria and has provided the full state match payment in one payment.
