State Severe Need School Breakfast Program Grant for School Year 2022-23

In accordance with legislative changes regarding available grants and funding pursuant to state statutes for school nutrition programs for school year (SY) 2022-23, attached is a list of schools that qualify for the State Severe Need School Breakfast Program (SBP) basic grant for SY 2022-23.

For the purpose of the grant, qualifying schools have met the following criteria:

- 1. Had indicated their intent to the Connecticut State Department of Education to participate in the SBP during SY 2022-23 by the start of the school year,
- 2. Are currently a school site serving breakfast under the SBP; and
- 3. Meet the statutory definition of Severe Need in SY 2019-20 (National School Lunch Program counts from July 1, 2019, through March 30, 2020).

Based on the availability of funds SFAs will receive approximately \$2,662 per eligible site(s).
