# SUBJECT:Operational Memorandum No. 15-23Healthy Food Certification (HFC) Payment for School Year 2022-23

In accordance with legislative changes regarding available grants and funding pursuant to state statutes for the school nutrition programs for school year (SY) 2022-23, attached is a list of school food authorities (SFA) that qualify for the HFC payment for SY 2022-23. For SY 2022-23, the Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) has established a HFC calculation to equitably distribute HFC funds based on the SFA meeting each of the three criteria below.

- 1. The SFA has certified to the CSDE that all food items sold to students separately from reimbursable meals will meet the Connecticut Nutrition Standards.
- 2. The SFA participated in the NSLP or SSO during SY 2021-22.
- 3. The SFA has NSLP counts from July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022, or the SFA has Seamless Summer Option (SSO) lunch counts from July 1, 2021, through September 30, 2022 (excluding community sites).

Based on the availability of funds SFAs will receive approximately \$.0828 cents per meal.

The CSDE has issued HFC payments for fiscal year 2022-23 to all SFAs that meet the established HFC criteria above. The HFC funds were paid in one payment.
