State Severe Need School Breakfast Program Grant for School Year 2023-24

In accordance with legislative changes regarding available grants and funding pursuant to state statutes for school nutrition programs for school year (SY) 2023-24, attached is a list of school food authorities (SFA) with schools that qualify for the State Severe Need School Breakfast Program (SBP) basic grant for SY 2023-24.

For the purpose of this grant, qualifying schools have met the following criteria:

- had indicated their intent to the Connecticut State Department of Education to participate in the SBP during SY 2023-24 by the start of the school year,
- · are currently a school site serving breakfast under the SBP; and
- meet the statutory definition of Severe Need in SY 2019-20 (National School Lunch Program counts from July 1, 2019, through March 30, 2020).

Based on the availability of funds SFAs will receive approximately \$2,652 per each eligible site.
