## USDA Foods Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC) Additional Items Available for School Year (SY) 2022-23: Due February 15, 2022

The USDA issued 2.9 million dollars to Connecticut to purchase bonus Direct Delivery items for SY 22-23. These funds are fair-shared based on each Recipient Agency's (RA's) 2018-19 lunch meal counts. Each RA will use their available funds to order from a CCC catalog that opens on February 3, 2022, and closes on February 15, 2022. This catalog is separate from the upcoming SY 2022-23 USDA Foods annual ordering period.

RAs will place all CCC orders in Web-Based Supply Chain Management (WBSCM). RAs should use the CSDE's CCC Bonus Items Ordering Worksheet to calculate the amount of items to order, staying **under** the allotted total.

Since this is a unique, one-time only offer, the WBSCM system cannot manage orders to prevent overordering. Please use the CCC Bonus Items Ordering Worksheet and pay careful attention to ensure your limit is not exceeded. Orders exceeding the allotted amount will be canceled. You may not have an additional chance to enter a corrected order due to the short turnaround for these orders.

#### **Instructions:**

- Review the CSDE's <u>CCC Bonus Items Ordering Amounts for Recipient Agencies</u> for your district's amount of allocated bonus dollars. These dollars will not count against your entitlement for USDA Foods.
- 2. Use the CSDE's CCC Bonus Items Ordering Worksheet to forecast your orders.
- 3. Place your orders in WBSCM, making sure to order up to (but not over) your allocated amount. **Note:** Any orders exceeding your allocated amount will be canceled and you may forfeit your bonus dollars.



In addition to the direct links above, the CCC documents are available in the "<u>Web-Based Supply Chain Management (WBSCM)</u>" section of the CSDE's Food Distribution Program (USDA Foods) webpage.

#### **Important notes:**

- Per-case delivery fee and case minimums still apply.
- These items will be shipped to the state warehouse in August or September 2022, for use in the NSLP during SY 2022-2023.
- Remember to consider these orders when you place your USDA Foods orders.
