USDA Foods Update: Wrapping Up School Year 2022-23

As a reminder, there are only two to three more USDA Foods deliveries from the HPC warehouse for this school year. Recipient Agencies (RAs) should continue to check monthly allocations and schedule deliveries as appropriate. The HPC warehouse received the last truck of orange juice cups last week, so all cases should be on the next available allocation report. For RAs with significant balances at this point in the school year, product may be transferred to another RA who has used their allocated USDA Foods.

Please continue to place orders for pounds diverted to processors as the sweep of all remaining pounds from this school year will proceed on June 30, 2023. For additional information on sweeps, please refer to Operational Memorandum No. 02-19: USDA Foods – Processing of USDA Foods.

Additional dollars are available for the USDA DoD Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program for this school year. Please contact the <u>Food Distribution Program (FDP) Staff</u> to request additional funds for balances that fall below 10% of original allocation. Prior to approving additional DoD Funds, the FDP will review current usage of all USDA Foods ordered for this school year.

Summer Training for New School Nutrition Directors: August 8-11, 2023

The CSDE, in conjunction with the Institute of Child Nutrition, will be hosting a training targeted towards new school nutrition directors (including directors who have been hired within the past three years). *Introduction to School Nutrition Leadership* will take place **August 8-11**, **2023**. Attendance is limited, and new school nutrition directors will be *expected to attend*. Resource Roundup: CSDE's Training Program: What's in a Meal Module 4: School Breakfast Program (SBP) Meal Pattern

This 18-minute module is the fourth in the CSDE's *What's in a Meal* training program. Module 4 reviews the breakfast meal pattern requirements (including the daily and weekly servings of each food component, the weekly requirement for whole grain-rich (WGR) foods, offering meat/meat alternates at breakfast, the weekly limit for juice, and the weekly dietary specifications) and describes resources for guidance and training on the SBP meal pattern.
