Operational Memorandum No. 15-23: Healthy Food Certification (HFC) Payment for School Year (SY) 2022-23

The CSDE's recently released <u>Operational Memorandum No. 15-23</u> indicates the calculation criteria for the HFC payments for SY 2022-23. This memorandum also includes a list of school food authorities that qualify for the HFC payment for SY 2022-23.

Updated Crediting Summary Charts for the School Nutrition Programs for SY 2023-23

The CSDE's crediting summary charts for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), School Breakfast Program (SBP), Afterschool Snack Program (ASP) are updated for SY 2023-24.
