Local Food for Schools Incentive Program (LFSIP) Reporting Requirements: Report of October 2023 Purchases Due November 21, 2023

Districts that would like to receive reimbursement from their LFSIP funds allocation for purchases of locally grown or produced foods for the month of **October 2023** must submit the <u>Monthly Local Foods for Schools Incentive Program (LFSIP) Reporting Form - Phase 1</u>. Purchases made in October 2023 should be reported on the form by **Tuesday, November 21, 2023**. Districts will be reimbursed for any approved purchases through the Connecticut Online Application and Claiming System for Child Nutrition Programs (CNP System).

Operational Memorandum No. 04-2024: Community Eligibility Provision: Implementing the New Minimum Identified Student Percentage

The CSDE Operational Memorandum No. 04-2024: Community Eligibility Provision: Implementing the New Minimum Identified Student Percentage provides important information regarding the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food and Nutrition Service's Final Rule, Child Nutrition Programs: Community Eligibility Provision – Increasing Options for Schools which lowers the minimum identified student percentage (ISP) for CEP school eligibility from 40 percent to 25 percent.

Reminder: Notify the CSDE Regarding Milk Supply Shortages

As a reminder, if there is an emergency with providing milk during breakfast or lunch service, local educational agencies (LEAs) must notify and receive approval from the CSDE's Bureau of Child Nutrition Programs before providing a meal that does not offer milk as part of the reimbursable meal. LEAs that are experiencing issues with offering milk should contact their school nutrition team member and copy Shannon Yearwood, Bureau Chief, Child Nutrition Programs. The email should include the information below.

- 1. The reason milk cannot be served.
- 2. The schools impacted.
- 3. The meal service impacted (i.e., breakfast, lunch, or both).
- 4. The estimated timeframe that milk will not be served.
