- <u>USDA Foods in Schools Product Information Sheets</u>: Provide a general compilation of vendor
  product information, but do not include specifics such as allergens, ingredients, and kosher or
  halal certifications, as those can vary from vendor to vendor.
- <u>USDA Foods Database</u>: Provides similar information to the Product Information Sheets and includes nutrient, allergen, ingredient, and certification information that is unique to each vendor.

These resources provide access to product information for USDA Foods to help schools meet the meal pattern requirements and make accommodations for students with dietary needs.

When was the last time the district checked their adult meal prices to ensure they are charging enough to cover all costs of producing adult meals? Assessing adult meal prices should not just occur when a sponsor is having an administrative review. This process should occur annually, ideally before the start of the school year. The CSDE's Nonprogram Pricing Worksheets for Adult Meals assists school food authorities with determining the appropriate prices for adult meals.
