DC Method 5: Eligible for Medicaid on CSDE's DC List


Directly certifies children for free or reduced-price meals and free milk

Not all children who qualify for Medicaid are directly certified for free or reduced-priced benefits

Must be on direct certification/S-EBT list





Reduced-price Eligibility through Medicaid

Reduced Medicaid status cannot negatively impact eligibility if determined free eligible


Determination of free eligible supersedes reduced Medicaid





Hierarchy of Eligibility: Example 1

Free benefits extend to all children in HH








