Keeping Data Current

- It is extremely important that student enrollment and demographic status is correct in PSIS.
- This information informs testing platforms (LAS Links, TIDE, College Board)
- Incorrect data fed into the PSIS system will result in downstream reporting issues as well as incorrect data for the Connecticut Accountability System Reporting.

• Students in tested grades who do not have *all seven* of the Testing Demographic fields completed.


Totals of Students for CT Testing Demographic Status Values

Sec. 10-198a. Policies and procedures concerning truants. (a) For purposes of this section and sections 10-198c and 10-220, "truant" means a child age five to eighteen, inclusive, who is enrolled in a public or private school and has four **unexcused** absences from school in any one month or ten **unexcused** absences from school in any school year.


